

Board of Governors June 2016 meeting highlights: addendum

The University of Saskatchewan Board of Governors held its regularly scheduled board meeting on June 21, 2016. The following is an addendum to the highlights of this meeting.

Board chair and vice-chair effective July 1, 2016

The board appointed Lee Ahenakew as chair and David Dubé as vice-chair of the University of Saskatchewan Board of Governors, effective July 1, 2016.

Lee Ahenakew, currently vice-chair of the Board of Governors, has been a member of the board since 2013. Lee currently leads a development corporation representing the business interests of the Battlefords Agency Tribal Chiefs member First Nations, and brings expertise in corporate Aboriginal relations and an understanding of the need to develop organizational strategies and processes to advance corporate social responsibility. He has a national reputation as a management consultant who is retained by major corporations to assist with developing strategies to engage Aboriginal organizations and communities.

David Dubé has also been a member of the board since 2013. David is the majority owner, controlling shareholder, president and CEO of Concorde Group Corp., and is a recognized investor and venture capitalist. David received a Bachelor of Arts in 1984, and is an active board member of multiple companies, non-profits and charitable organizations.

Current board chair, Greg Smith, will remain on the Board of Governors until a replacement has been named by the provincial government through an Order in Council.
