COLLEGE OF LAW

The following provides additional information from the College of Law regarding implementation of the changes approved in the <u>September</u>, 2012 University Course Challenge.

Juris Doctor

Starting in 2013-2014 students in their second year must complete Administrative Law 340.3. In their second or third year students must also take Legal Ethics and Professionalism 421.3 as well as one of three other courses, Business Organizations I 361.3, Trusts 326.3 or Fiduciary Obligations 463.3.

These changes were implemented in order to comply with competency requirements established by the Federation of Law Societies of Canada for graduates with common law degrees who intend to apply for entry to provincial bars and law societies as of 2015.

Juris Doctor (J.D.)

Year 1

During first year, students must also complete Legal Research & Writing <u>LAW 243.0</u> in which students must receive a grade of 60% or better.
