Summary

1. Association of Saskatchewan Home Economics

The Committee was informed that the Association of Saskatchewan Home Economics has formally disbanded. As a result, the Association's designated seat on Senate has been relinquished.

2. Recognition of Indigenous Governments

This item was introduced as a continuation of discussions from the previous year. The matter is currently under review. Updates will be provided as the review progresses. Committee members will receive a summary of the work completed to date.

3. Guidelines and Criteria for Association Membership

The Committee reviewed the existing guidelines for association membership, last updated in April 2024. Following discussion, the Committee agreed to maintain the current approach without changes. The guidelines will be circulated to ensure all members are informed of the current criteria and process.
