- the university secretary
- the dean of the college or the executive director of the school responsible for the class (if a specific class is involved)
- the instructor(s) responsible for the class (if a specific class is involved)
- the dean of the college or the executive director of the school in which the student is registered

A written statement outlining the allegation must be attached to this form; additional supplementary written information may also be attached.
